POPE BENEDICT XVI and EUCHARISTIC ADORATION – "An intrinsic connection exists between celebration and adoration. In fact, Holy Mass is in itself the Church's greatest act of adoration: "No one eats of this flesh", as St Augustine writes, "without having first adored it".
