Over the next few weeks, the Archbishop will consider who will take up the appointment to the parishes of Batemans Bay and Moruya. He has asked the priests of the Archdiocese to keep this in their prayers. He will meet with the Consultors towards the end of May to assist him in making this appointment. In doing so he considers both the needs of both parishes and also the needs of other parishes in the Archdiocese. He will make this known when the person has been consulted and has accepted the appointment.

Jesus calls us to listen to his voice and his lead. He seeks us out so that we may discover what truly nourishes us.
