A message from Fr Dominic

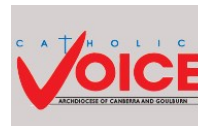
Just moments before Jesus takes these disciples up the mountain he tells them, "he was to undergo suffering in Jerusalem, that he was going to die at the hands of the chief priests, the elders and the Scribes" (Mat 16: 21). He then leads them on the journey, up the mountain, where they hear the voice of the Father, see Moses and Elijah, and Jesus reveals to them his Divinity. Not much more could be shown to them! It is also shown to us just through our hearing about it. When we turn to God we want him to see us, we want to be with him and when we are with him nothing can remain hidden, all will be illuminated. Jesus does Transfigure us when we receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation. Imagine journeying up a mountain and wondering off the path. When you return to the path you are facing in the right direction but you bring with you some of what you wondered into, be it mud or other things. It is only Jesus who can clean this off. It is only Him who can reach back through time and erase it. But, it is only you who can admit the need to be cleansed. When Moses came down from the mountain his face shone (Ex 34: 29), so should ours.
