St Mary's Primary School Community Council Bulb Express Fundraiser

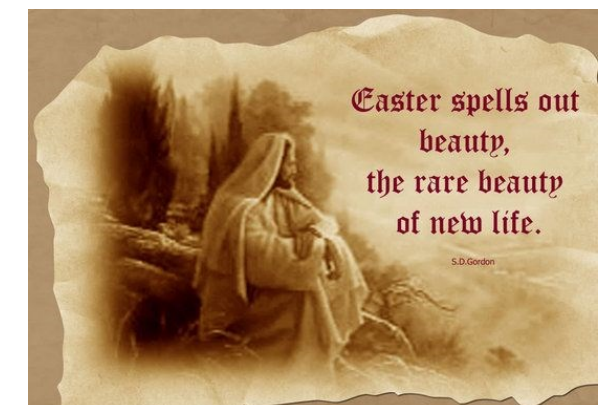
