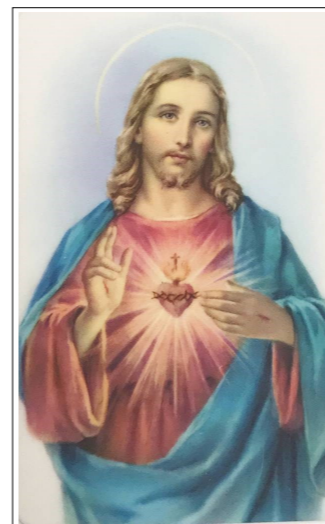

A Message from Fr. Dominic

Today's Gospel contrasts those who are being cast out in readiness for the coming Kingdom (i.e., the fallen angels) with those who have 'done the will of God' and are being welcomed into Jesus family, beginning the reign of the Kingdom of God. This whole story just typifies how far wrong things had gone. Both the immediate family of Jesus and the Scribes, who come down from Jerusalem, are unfamiliar with the nature of Jesus' words and actions. Jesus is so misunderstood that he is treated like a teenager, like a disruptive family member. All this confusion takes place as Jesus is arriving home after he has appointed the twelve Apostles who are to start what will become his new family, our Church. This weekend, the children will be fully initiated into our Church with the Sacrament of Confirmation. The twelve Apostles received the Holy Spirit on Pentecost, in the upper room, and our Archbishop shares this gift given to them so that we might also be fully united in Christ and, 'be sealed with the gift of the Holy Spirit.' It is confusing when people come asking for one Sacrament (Baptism) but do not want the sacrament of matrimony or ask for another Sacrament but do not want to come to Mass and receive the Eucharist. Spiritual people are intimately aware of the Sanctity of life. They should be hungry for more of this.

Almighty and eternal God, look upon the Heart of Thy most beloved Son and upon the praises and satisfaction which He offers Thee in the name of sinners; and to those who implore Thy mercy, in Thy great goodness, grant forgiveness in the name of the same Jesus Christ, Thy Son, who livest and reignest with Thee.
