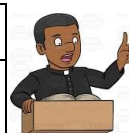

A Message from Fr. Dominic

In today's second reading Saint Paul reminds us that our lives are meant to redeem this poor distracted world. We will do so when we allow our inner selves to be transformed by God who dwells within us. In one of the documents of the Second Vatican Council (Sacrosanctum Concilium) we find this thought: When we offer the Mass, we are invited by the Church to offer ourselves, so that when the bread and wine are transformed by God into the body and blood of Christ, we are transformed with them, so that our heart gradually becomes the heart of Jesus, so that our thoughts become his thoughts, our love becomes his love, our judgments become his. In this way we become more and more perfectly united to God and to all those who receive communion with us (see Vatican II, SC., N. 48). This is at the very centre of what it means to be parish and what it means to live Communion.
