#### A Message from Fr. Dominic

There is a key in Luke's Gospel that appears after today's passage that helps us put today's Gospel in perspective. In Luke's Gospel Jesus says, "To you it has been granted to know the mysteries of the kingdom of God, but to the rest it is in parables, so that SEEING THEY MAY NOT SEE, AND HEARING THEY MAY NOT UNDERSTAND" (Lk. 8: 10). What is being said here is all about the spirit... utterly unknown to those who are not spiritual. The whole point of this reading is to urge us to be true to our promise to follow Jesus and to say that Jesus is the one who has eternal life. When we choose not to follow, we will be just like those who did not believe...they will be left behind. Our faith helps us see where life has come from and how it is sustained...it also helps us to see death... it helps us to see that death is a return to the author of life...our faith helps us see both life and death...giving us true depth of vision. Others could ask us, 'how can you believe in a God who came to us from heaven but then died?' We can ask them, 'how can you believe that death is a return to nothing as if life had come from nothing to begin with?'
