Working With Children Checks

There have been recent legislative changes around the NSW Working With Children Check that are important for our volunteers.

Everyone who holds a NSW WWC check is now legally required to update any change to their personal details, including name and address changes, within three months of the change. **Penalties apply if details are not updated.** Updating your details is simple - go to the Kids Guardian website <https://www.kidsguardian.nsw.gov.au/> and follow the directions. You can also find your WWC number here if you don't have it on hand.

We have a number of volunteers due to renew their WWC numbers in the near future and we hope this information is helpful. Please do not hesitate to contact us if we can assist in any way.
