I write to inform you that I have accepted a request from **Fr Warrick Tonkin** to resign from his role as Administrator of St Christopher's Cathedral Parish due to medical reasons. This resignation includes his roles as Director of Formation of the Permanent Diaconate, Chairman of the Liturgical Commission, Diocesan Censor and Master of Ceremonies.
