Today's Gospel message comes from Fr Dominic

Just imagine in Jerusalem today, devastated by conflict and hate, being guided by a person who says that we should all repent in order for this conflict to be ended. Imagine this person saying, 'what we need to do is repent because this is how your relationship with God is brought back into full communion and peace restored.' This is how we prepare to receive peace. The idea that God can forgive your sins and wash away the things that you have done is something that those who lived in the time of John the Baptist would have welcomed as they lived in close community with each other and were most keenly aware of everybody's faults. This reminds me of some women who go to confession and say, "Father I do not think that I have done anything wrong...but let me tell you about my husband..." It is always someone else. At least these women understand the importance of confession, as it seems the men of today do not.
