### **Gaudete Sunday**

This weekend marks the end of the first part of the advent season, counting from the first Sunday of advent to  $16^{tr}$ December, ushering us into the second part with the celebration of Gaudete Sunday (Rejoice Sunday). During the mass, we light the rose-coloured candle to lighten the mood as we cross the mid-point between the start of the season and the joy that comes with the anticipation of the celebration of Christmas.

Advent is a season with rhythm. This can be seen in the organisation of the liturgy and the symbolic rituals of the season. Central to this rhythm is the Word.

In our first weekend, St. Luke in the text of the Gospel presented the image of the destruction of the earth, the coming of the Son of Man and judgement. This fire-alarm approach is meant to create spiritual anxiety. To calm the anxiety, the second weekend offered a voice; a voice crying in the wilderness: prepare the way of the Lord... In this third weekend, the voice of John is giving precise direction to his audience who came asking: what should we do?

As we go through this week, we pray for the grace to respond as appropriate to the demands of John's voice. Fr. Martins
