- 1. The first collection is for the support of clergy in the parish and beyond. Each priest in a parish draws a personal stipend from the first collection for living expenses, food and housekeeping.
- The second collection is for the maintenance and growth of our parish's mission. For example: Liturgical needs, Salaries, Utilities, Resources, Maintenance of churches, Repayment of loans, Parish sacramental formation and pastoral programs.
