Thank you also to the Filipino Community for supplying morning tea for everyone.

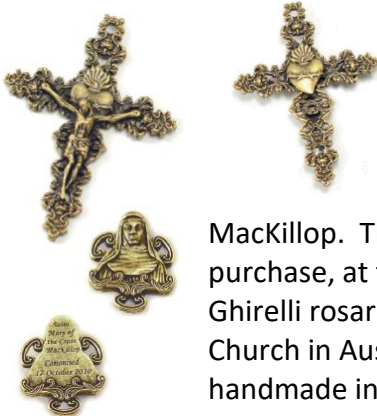


Commemorative Saint Mary MacKillop Rosary Beads
