David was very much a man who "did things without seeking notice" so many would not be aware of the immense contribution he made to our Immaculate Conception Parish. Some of the highlights of David's contribution included facilitating the sale of the old parish house, the upgrading of electricity to the church and St Mary's hall, continual maintenance to inside of Church, repairing of cracks, painting/patching etc, and setting up the audio system in the Church.

David facilitated the lighting up of both the primary and secondary carparks, plus co-opting other parish members to assist in the carrying out of chores both inside and outside the Church.

David co-opted assistance to help with the total refurbishment of the original convent into the Parish house, plus carrying out an upgrade to the Chapel.

David's mind seemed to be always thinking of ways to make improvements in our Parish community, and I'm sure there are many other minor works that many of us would never have noticed have been completed both in the Church as well as in and around the Parish house, that David was responsible for.

Thank you David for your immense generosity with your skills, time and with resources. Our Parish owes an immense debt of gratitude to you.

The Solemnity of the Assumption of Mary 15th August.

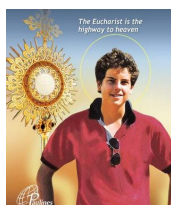
With her Yes, to the Lord, God called her to be the Mother of Jesus and the Mother of the Church.

Pope Leo XIV held the first Ordinary Public Consistory of his pontificate on Friday morning, with Cardinals giving their formal approval for the canonizations of eight Blesseds. During the ceremony, the Holy Father announced that Blessed Carlo Acutis will be canonized on Sunday, **7 September in Rome**. The canonization of this young saint, will be the first millennial saint.
