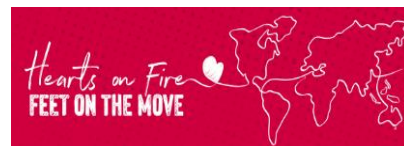
All parishioners are welcome to come and pray for their deceased loved ones. Candles will be available to place before the Alter as an offering of prayer and remembrance during Mass.
