Pentecost

Pentecost is the commemoration of the descent of the Holy Spirit upon the Apostles and Mary our Mother while they were in Jerusalem celebrating the Feast of Weeks, as described in the Acts of the Apostles. The Church celebrates the Pentecost on the 50th Day after the Easter Sunday, Sunday 28th April, 11.30am one and a half hours – 1st 30mins Adoration, 2nd 30mins Rosary and 3rd 30mins Praise and Singing Hymns. Please bring a plate of food to share with each other. Let us pray for the outpouring of the Holy Spirit into our lives and the life of the Church on Pentecost Sunday.



Novena to the Holy Spirit
