you intercede for us with your Son.*

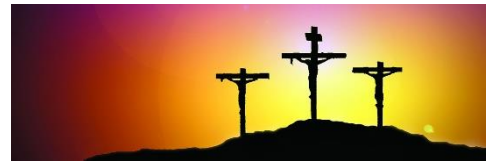
*O Mary conceived without sin,

A Message from Pope Francis

In the Archdiocese's "Year of Walking Together", Archbishop Prowse underlined in his homily the themes of Christian unity, solidarity, and equality.

Quoting from Pope Francis directly, "**The path that God is indicating to the Church is precisely that of a more intense and concrete experience of communion and journeying together.**"

He asks the Church to leave behind ways of acting separately, on parallel tracks that never meet. These people did not say: "I am a Bishop" or "I am a Lay person..." No, they said simply: "I am a Christian"... We are baptised: We are Christian: We are Disciples of Jesus. Everything else is secondary." How can we connect for the greater glory of God?
