A Message from Pope Francis

In the Archdiocese's "Year of Walking Together", Archbishop Prowse underlined in his homily the themes of Christian unity, solidarity, and equality.

Quoting from Pope Francis directly, "The path that God is indicating to the Church is precisely that of a more intense and concrete experience of communion and journeying together."

He asks the Church to leave behind ways of acting separately, on parallel tracks that never meet.

These people did not say: "I am a Bishop" or "I am a Lay person..." No, they said simply: "I am a Christian"... We are baptised: We are Christian: We are Disciples of Jesus. Everything else is secondary." How can we connect for the greater glory of God?
