Please come for Communion from the RIGHT aisle only (as you are facing the altar), receive Communion from Fr and the Acolyte in an alternate fashion, and then return to your seats via the LEFT aisle only (organ side). RIGHT seats first, MIDDLE seats second, LEFT seats third. Please allow 1.5m per person.

A reminder that Communion is to be received in the hand.

FACE MASKS

The NSW Government is strongly encouraging greater use of masks in high-risk public settings, including attendance at religious gatherings, to help prevent the spread of COVID-19. Wearing a mask is **not mandatory but is highly recommended**, especially in areas where there has been community transmission.
