STAINED GLASS WINDOWS

Our Parish has been successful in obtaining a Grant from the Blakeney Millar Foundation. This Grant of \$25,000, is specifically to carry out major repairs to two stained glass windows in our Church, namely St Michael and Sacred Heart windows (adjacent to pulpit). Removal of the windows will be undertaken in the next few weeks.

COVID19 PROTOCOLS

COLLECTIONS: Please deposit your offerings in the collection boxes provided

SINGING: Please note that according to the COVID-19 Safety Plan for Places of Worship developed by NSW Health congregational singing is to be **avoided** and solo singers are to maintain at least 3m physical distance. Singing with facemasks is not a current alternative. Solo singers, or pre-recorded singing is allowed.

COMMUNION: is distributed in an anti-clockwise cycle (as you are facing the altar), up the right hand aisle and return via the left. Organ side pews first, middle rows second, pulpit side last. Please **give 1.5m distance between people**, and remain seated until your turn.

FACE MASKS: Wearing a mask in religious gatherings is **not mandatory but is highly recommended**, especially in areas where there has been community transmission.

CLEANING: Please wipe any surfaces you come into contact with, with the wipes provided, when you visit the church for Mass or private prayer and dispose in the bins provided as you exit.
