SERMON ON THE PLAIN

The Sermon on the Plain as its corresponding passage - the Sermon on the Mount - in Matthew, has been called The Christian Manifesto as it sets out the values and ideals of the Christian Life in the Kingdom. It is a pledge to be detached from all that is not of God and that one's life be guided by what is conducive to the service of God or, to put it another way, by what is conducive to the end for which we were created. They are difficult passages to understand and equally difficult to have as the guiding principles of our lives.

Pray for all who experience rejection, denunciation or hostility; I pray that I may see in them what Jesus sees and I consider what Jesus wants me to learn from them.

Who wants to be poorer, sad, in conflict, excluded or demeaned? Jesus does not ask us to seek out discomfort, but wants us to realise that God always holds a brighter promise for us.
