COVID PROTOCOLS UPDATE

Updated Covid rules for places of worship NSW From Monday 7th December:

- 4sq metre rule is now the 2sq metre rule both outdoors and indoors. Approx 130 allowed in the church
- Singing allowed both indoors or outdoors masks recommended but not mandatory.
- Covid safe plans are still required for major events, i.e. outdoor Masses.
- Hygiene and social distancing are still important and sign-in is still a requirement.

ARCHBISHOPS CHRISTMAS APPEAL
