Father God, thank you for our church and its people.


Fill us with your Holy Spirit so that our church may grow.

The Eucharist is the "source and summit of the Christian life" (Second Vatican Council, Lumen gentium, no. 11). each one of us. Yet, as God Himself, the Body and Blood of Christ deserves our utmost respect and love, as well as our adoration.
