LATEST COVID-19 PROTOCOL UPDATES

SINGING: Please note that according to the COVID-19 Safety Plan for Places of Worship developed by NSW Health congregational singing is to be **avoided** and solo singers are to maintain at least 3m physical distance. Singing with facemasks is not a current alternative. Solo singers, or pre-recorded singing is allowed.

SIGN IN & SANITISE: As part of our Covid Safe Plan we require a register of people in the church, pens provided, sanitiser provided, sanitising wipes will soon be introduced for parishioners to wipe the surfaces of the seat they occupy.

COMMUNION: Please proceed single file for communion and return to your seats via the outside perimeter aisle either side. Please allow 1.5m per person.

FACE MASKS: Wearing a mask is **not mandatory but is highly recommended**.
