O Mary, Mother of Jesus and our Mother, you intercede for us with your Son.

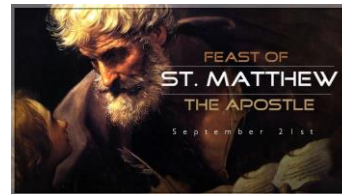
O Mary conceived without sin, pray for us who have recourse to thee.
