The month of October is dedicated to the Rosary and we are encouraged to pray this prayer daily.

The Rosary is a summary of the whole Gospel and recalls the major events in Christ's life from his conception (annunciation) through to his death and resurrection.

Pope John Paul II said "the Rosary, though clearly Marian in character, is at heart a Christocentric prayer. It is a compendium of the Gospel, in which we pray to Christ with Mary.
