NOVEMBER - HOLY SOULS

November, which is not too far away, is traditionally the month of Holy Souls, the parish will be setting up a special rememberance display so please make note to bring forward the names of deceased family and friends, as well as forgotten souls, to be offered.

We can help the Poor Souls in Purgatory in many ways, all of which involve prayer and sacrifice. First, we can offer Holy Mass (and one's reception of Holy Communion) for them. We can bring our own petitions to the Lord during the prayers of the faithful but more importantly, at the very moment of His greatest act of love. In addition to praying at Mass, you can also have Masses said for the Poor Souls. For a small stipend (eg \$5-10), you can reserve dates on which the Masses will be offered especially for the souls in Purgatory. Make use of the Mass Offering envelopes for this practice.

"May the souls of the faithful departed, through the mercy of God, rest in peace." Simple, but powerful.
