COVID PROTOCOLS UPDATE

Updated Covid rules for places of worship NSW From Monday 7th December:

- 4sq metre rule is now the 2sq metre rule both outdoors and indoors.
- Outdoor Masses can have 3,000 (complying with 2sq metre rule) even with BYO chairs.
- Singing allowed both indoors or outdoors masks recommended but not mandatory.
- Covid safe plans are still required for major events, i.e. outdoor Masses.
- Hygiene and social distancing are still important and sign-in is still a requirement.

Thank you to all our parishioners for maintaining all the changes we've had this year, and we continue to pray for those in places where they still cannot gather to worship and receive the Eucharist.
