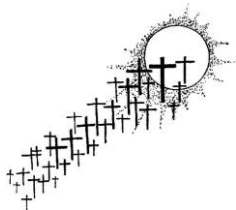

The motion passed this week says that after the Voluntary Assisted Dying Bill 2021 is passed in the Lower House, then an Upper House Committee will review the Bill and report back by the first sitting day of Parliament next year.
