Pentecost

Pentecost is the commemoration of the descent of the Holy Spirit upon the Apostles And Mary our Mother while they were in Jerusalem celebrating the Feast of Weeks, as described in the Acts of the Apostles. The Church celebrates the Pentecost on the 50th Day after the Easter Sunday. The Mission will celebrate this feast at the Tumut Church with exposure of the Blessed Sacrament for private prayer from 11.30 am to 12.00 pm, the Rosary from 12.00 to 12.30 pm and community prayer and hymn singing from 12.30 pm to 1.00 pm. Please bring a plate of food for lunch to share with each other on Pentecost Sunday. Lunch will be held in Saint Mary's Hall.
