Yesterday we celebrated the Baptism of Caila & Tristan Sanderson the beautiful children of Lisa & Campbell Sanderson.


Lord, please bless these small and sweet children of your creation, such little miracles of love.

The Feast of the Baptism of the Lord

Mass celebrating the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord will be held on Monday 8th January at 10am

In the liturgical calendar, the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord signifies the end of the Christmas season. The Baptism of the Lord is notable because it marks the beginning of Jesus' ministry and confirms his identity as the Son of God.

Christ's baptism remarkably shows all three Persons of the Trinity at the same time: the Son being baptized, the Holy Spirit descending, and the Father speaking from the heavens. In this event, the Father and the Holy Spirit confirm the deity of Christ, and Jesus submits to his Father's will.
