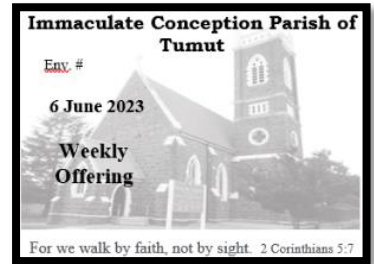
Prayer for the Parish Mission

Regular Sunday Collections

There are generally two collections taken up at Mass.

1. The first collection is for the support of clergy in the parish and beyond. Each priest in a parish draws a personal stipend from the first collection for living expenses, food and housekeeping.
2. The second collection is for the maintenance and growth of our parish's mission. For example: Liturgical needs, Salaries, Utilities, Resources, Maintenance of churches, Repayment of loans, Parish sacramental formation and pastoral programs.

Don't Get Ahead of God!

'In due season He will honour you with every blessing' Psalm 37:34

When God gives you a promise or a vision for your life, it's like a seed; it needs time to take root before it can grow and then bear fruit. It's like the birth of a baby. First conception, then pregnancy, and finally the day of delivery. And what do the parents do during this time? Prepare! They get ready for the challenges and responsibilities of parenthood. You may think you are ready, but God knows when you're ready.

We must learn the difference between what we can do and what God can do. Fools rush in! If you don't want to risk delaying the fulfilment of God's plan for your life, don't get ahead of Him. God has scheduled a time for bringing to pass two things in your life: His promises and your vision. And there is great peace in knowing that nothing the enemy does can pre-empt these two things. So, when you grow impatient, remind yourself, "My life can't end without this happening. God said it, and He will do it!"
