Effective Monday 7 December 2020

NSW Parishes Only

Mass, Liturgies, Weddings & Funerals

Apply the 2m<sup>2</sup> rule for all liturgical celebrations.

This will mean that most Churches can have up to approximately 200.

QR Codes are available in NSW, but are not compulsory
