Holy Week Explanation and History

Holy Week is the week proceeding Easter. The week is observed throughout the Catholic Church. It is a period of devotion to the death and resurrection of Christ (The Passion). The various traditional rites of the week probably began to develop at Jerusalem in the 4th century when pilgrimages became easily possible and Christians could indulge a natural desire to re-enact the last scenes of the life of Christ in liturgical drama. The pilgrimage of Etheria, a documented variously dated in the 4th and 6th century gives a detail account of the contemporary observance of Holy Week in Jerusalem.

Ceremonies of Holy Week

Palm Sunday-Celebrates the entrance of Christ into Jerusalem to accomplish his mission on earth.

Holy Thursday-Celebrates the institution of the Eucharist and the ministerial priesthood.

Good Friday-Celebrates the death of Christ.

Easter Vigil-Celebrates the waiting for and the resurrection of Christ.

Easter-Celebrates the Resurrection.
