COVID-19

NSW Parishes Only

Current Situation in open LGA areas

Masks are mandatory, except children under 12.

1. Gatherings are to observe the 4sqm rule.

2. No singing.

3. Service NSW app to be used for COVID Safe Check-in.

4. Parish Offices Open.

Beginning Monday 11 October 2021

6. 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 apply.

7. Mass only for those who are fully vaccinated. 8. Weddings for those unvaccinated restricted to 5 guests, otherwise apply 4sqm rule.

9. Funerals for those unvaccinated restricted to 10 people, otherwise apply 4sqm rule.

Beginning Monday 18 October 2021

10. 1, 2, 3, 4 apply.

11. Mass, Weddings, Funerals: for fully vaccinated and those who are not.

-The Body of Christ offered and received, not the Precious Blood. Received in the hand, not on the tongue.

-Sign of Peace - no touching.

-Music: Permitted and encouraged.

-Singing: Not permitted.

-Cash Collections: Encouraged, with touching minimised.
