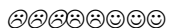
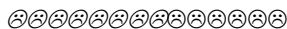

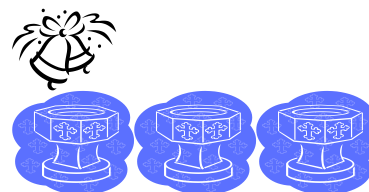
**Friday 12.00noon – Mass-Church preceded by Holy Hour before the Blessed Sacrament at NEW ASSOCIATE PRIEST**

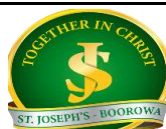
