Archdiocesan Protocols COVID-19

1. Masks are mandatory in both the ACT and NSW in all indoor spaces:

a. The celebrant removes the mask as he begins the Liturgy up until the distribution of Holy Communion, when it must be worn. It is removed again for the Purification, Prayer After Communion and Final Blessing. It must be worn for the procession out.

b. Lectors remove their mask when proclaiming the Word of God, prayers of the faithful, etc.

c. Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion (EMHC) wear masks when distributing the Sacred Host.

2. Music is permitted and encouraged to enhance the Liturgy, but not singing until further notice:

a. If the choir is sufficiently distanced from the congregation, then prudent judgement can permit singing by choir only.

3. Reception of Holy Communion:

a. Sacred Host only, not the Precious Blood. **b.** Communion in the hand only, not on the tongue, until further notice (due to the highly contagious nature of the latest variant of COVID-19).
