Updated Archdiocesan Protocols

COVID 19

*Effective Monday 7 December 2020*

*NSW Parishes Only*

*Mass, Liturgies, Weddings & Funerals*

Apply the 2m<sup>2</sup> rule for all liturgical celebrations.

This will mean that most Churches can have up to approximately 200.

QR Codes are available in NSW, but are not compulsory

QR Codes require mobile phones and do not keep count of participants. Some parishioners will still need to sign in via a Mass Registry. In addition, parishes will need to monitor numbers

Physical or digital Mass Register to be kept for 30 days

Availability of hand sanitiser is essential

Holy Communion only under the species of bread

Families can sit together, but in relation to other persons/families apply 2m<sup>2</sup> rule

Singing is possible, respecting 2m<sup>2</sup> rule, people facing the same direction.
