Dear Parishioners,

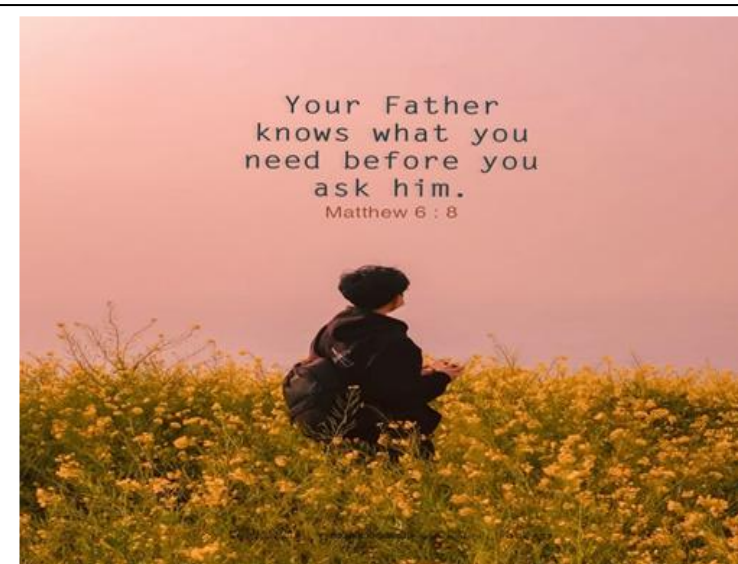
We want to inform you that Fr. Jiss has traveling to India to visit his beloved parents from this week until mid-November. We encourage you to keep him in your prayers during his time away.

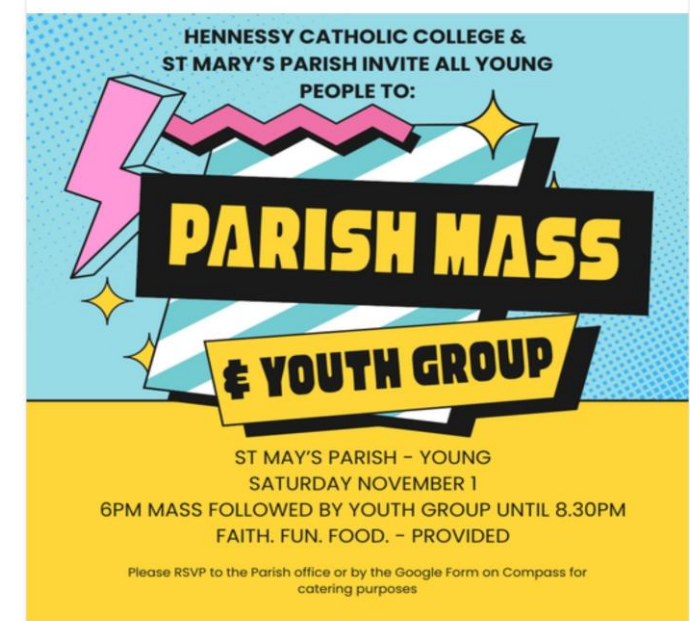
