"The open day will start in the emergency department where we will simulate an emergency response to showcase the skills of our staff and demonstrate the use of the Remote Medical Consultation Service, a virtual care system that enables us to call on a doctor at any time, day or night," Nicole said. "We will also demonstrate the new Emergency Care and Treatment (ECAT) protocols that our highly trained staff use to ensure patients start their treatment as soon as possible and spend less time in the emergency department. "No-one plans to end up in the emergency department, but we hope that seeing our team in action, and the technology that we have available, is reassuring for anyone who finds themselves in need of emergency care in the future." Following the emergency scenario and hospital demonstrations, guests will be able to participate in tours of the hospital and aged care wing.
