

#### 1. Parish Offices are closed.

2. Churches and chapels are **closed.** 

3. Public Masses and other Public Liturgies are **not** to be celebrated. However: Funerals (10 people only, not including ministers) are permitted. Weddings (5 people only, couple, minister, two witnesses) are permitted. 4. Holy Communion can be taken to the sick.

5. Anointing of the Sick can be celebrated.

6. Visitation to hospitals by priests should be minimal (rely on designated hospital chaplains where possible). 7. Face Masks are mandatory.
