A little Historical Fact:

All Souls' Day was standardized during the 11th century

The date of All Souls' Day has been standardized as 2 November since the 10th or 11th century, due to the efforts of Abbot Odilo of Cluny. Before this, Catholic congregations celebrated All Souls' Day during the Easter season on different dates. This is still the case for some Eastern Orthodox Churches, who commemorate the faithful departed on the Friday before Lent. From the Cluniac monasteries, the date and

customs of alms, prayers and sacrifices spread to the rest of the Western Church. Almsgiving was linked with fasting and prayer for the dead by Odilo when he decreed that those requesting a Mass be offered should make an offering for the poor. The standardised date was adopted in Rome in the 13th century.
