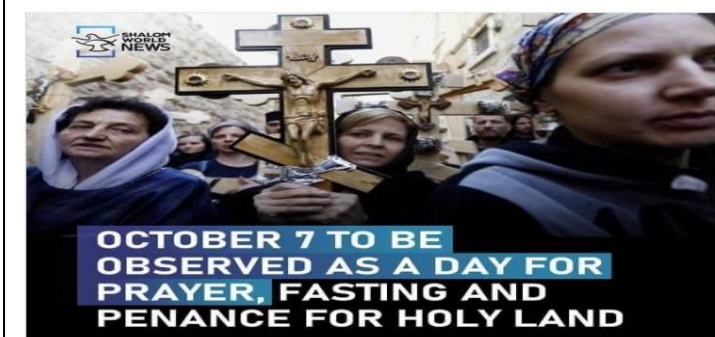
If you are happy to be part of this significant celebration, please make a donation or pay \$35 -00 for a seat.
