### Archdiocesan Protocols COVID-19

**1.** Masks are mandatory in both the ACT and NSW in all indoor spaces:

**a.** The celebrant removes the mask as he begins the Liturgy up until the distribution of Holy Communion, when it must be worn. It is removed again for the Purification, Prayer After Communion and Final Blessing. It must be worn for the procession out.

**b.** Lectors remove their mask when proclaiming the Word of God, prayers of the faithful, etc.

**c.** Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion (EMHC) wear masks when distributing the Sacred Host.

**2.** Music is permitted and encouraged to enhance the Liturgy, but not singing until further notice:

**a.** If the choir is sufficiently distanced from the congregation, then prudent judgement can permit singing by choir only.

**3.** Reception of Holy Communion:

**a.** Sacred Host only, not the Precious Blood. **b.** Communion in the hand only, not on the tongue, until further notice (due to the highly contagious nature of the latest variant of COVID-19).

In 2022, the event will be hosted by the Diocese of Rome with Pope Francis leading special celebrations. However, the Holy Father has also asked that the World Meeting of Families be celebrated concurrently in every diocese of the world in 2022. The idea is for families to gather locally around their bishop to explore and celebrate the theme of "Family love: a vocation and a path to holiness" In our Archdiocese of Canberra Goulburn it is envisaged that celebrations will happen in three locations: one in Canberra, one in the Eastern Deanery and one in the Western Deanery. MERCY Sister Janet Mead, who earned gold records for her 1974 hit version of the Our Father, died on Australia Day aged 84, after battling cancer.

In 1974, "The Lord's Prayer," set to an uptempo rock beat, scaled up the charts, peaking at No. 3 in Australia and No.4 in the United States, earning her gold records for the single.
