### Archdiocesan Protocols COVID-19 Safety

#### Effective Monday 28 June 2021 NSW Parishes Only Masses, Weddings, Liturgies, Gatherings

1. Masks are mandatory for those 12 years +
2. Priest (when celebrating Liturgy) and Lectors (when proclaiming the Word) can dispense with the mask
3. Priest and Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion must wear masks when distributing the Sacred Host
4. No congregational singing, but a cantor (x4) can sing if 4m<sup>2</sup> from congregation
5. Holy Communion only under the species of bread
6. Holy Communion to be received only in the hand
7. No touching at the sign of peace
8. Collection bags not to be passed around, but can be placed on an extended stick to allow collection of cash by a few parishioners
9. Apply the 4m<sup>2</sup> rule to all liturgies and gatherings (except funerals).

#### Funerals

10. Restricted to 100 persons.

#### Other Matters

11. Service NSW App is mandatory.
12. Physical roster is reasonable for those who are unable to use the App (keep for 30 days).
13. Availability of hand sanitiser is essential.
14. Families can sit together, but in relation to other persons/families apply 4m<sup>2</sup> rule.
