The safety of Parishioners is evervone's responsibility. With ongoing repairs within the church & it surrounds it is important that everyone stays safe. Please be careful of any areas that are cordoned off. Care & Concern also extends to the carpark. Please note no parking marking & do not park in areas that block entrances & exits. Please also pull forward to allow everyone the possibility to park correctly.

As you are all aware there have been a lot of repairs going on within our Church. Thank you all for your patience, the end is in sight.

Works completed: The roof has been repaired, ceiling have been repaired, the pipe leak was found & stopped, the foyer tiles have been repaired / replaced, carpet in sacristy cleaned. Still to go: Repairs to Sacristy cupboard, filling of hole out the front & replacing pavers. Restoration of water to sinks at the back of the church at our own cost. (quotes pending) For your own safety please stay away from cordoned off areas.

Costs: Parish costs include insurance excess 2 x \$500, roof make safe \$500, roof repair \$6,800 & pipe diversion allowance \$1,700. Insurance covered the cost of repair of ceiling, leak investigations & restoration of fixtures & fitting & is estimated to be in excess of \$20,000.

St Thomas has a Quest Payment System. There is an EFTPOS tap & go machine in the fover preloaded with \$5 to enable parishioners to donate \$5 by tapping your EFTPOS card to the machine. Want to donate more simply tap your card again. All money goes to St Thomas to help with running the Parish (including repair costs).

Tap & Go Donations for the last few weeks, 28/29 Sep, \$75. 5/6 Oct, \$85. 12/13 Oct, \$145. Many thanks to those who tried the machine. Machine is here to stay. Have a go.
