What's next: The water is again turned off & toilets & taps are not to be used, please use the facilities in the meeting room. Investigations have began to try & find the cause of this leak. Lucky the damaged cupboard had not yet been repaired, these repairs will be delayed until we have a resolution, as has the replacing of the pavers & filling of the holes.

**Restoration:** Water to sinks at the back of the church at our own cost is also delayed. For your own safety please stay away from cordoned off areas.

Costs: Parish costs insurance excess 2 x \$500, roof make safe \$500, roof repair \$6,800 & pipe diversion \$1,700. We are hopeful that this further damage will be covered by insurance.
