As you are all aware there have been a lot of repairs going on within our Church. Thank you all for your patience. Unfortunately the water has come back up in the Sacristv. The insurance has been informed & the plumber is on the job.

What's next: The water is again turned off & toilets & taps are not to be used, please use the facilities in the meeting room. Investigations have began to try & find the cause of this leak. This is a new claim as far as the insurance is concerned. Lucky the damaged cupboard had not yet been repaired, these repairs will be delayed until we have a resolution, as has the replacing of the payers & filling of the holes. We are currently getting guotes for this extra work.

Restoration: Water to sinks at the back of the church at our own cost is also delayed. For your own safety please stay away from cordoned off areas.

Costs: Parish costs insurance excess 3 x \$500, roof make safe \$500, roof repair \$6,800 & pipe diversion \$1,700. We are hopeful that this further damage will be covered by insurance.

St Thomas has a Quest Payment System. The EFTPOS tap & go machine is back. You can donate \$10 by tapping your EFTPOS card to the machine. Want to donate more simply tap your card again. All money goes to St Thomas to help with running the Parish (& repair costs). Last weekend \$170 was donated. Many thanks to those who tried the machine. Have a go.
