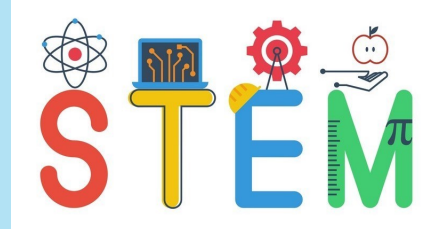

Our fete cannot run without the assistance volunteers.

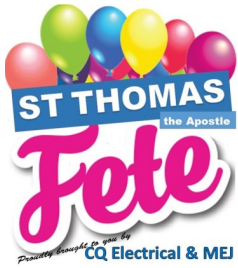

BEAUTY STALL – coloured hairspray, nail polish and temporary tattoos

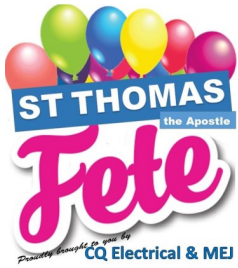
CRAFTS - and knitting for our wonderful Craft Stall

Cake Stall – Plates and Recipes

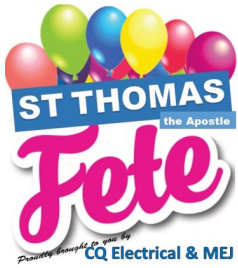
Last years Cake Stall was the best ever and this year we will be just as awesome!

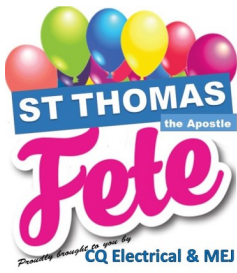

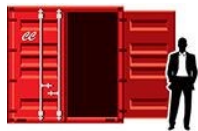
