As we approach Holy Week, we are pleased that so many good things are happening in our faith community to keep us socially and spiritually together, if physically separated.

The St Mary's COVID-19 Working Group has been continuing to work keep our community in contact while containing the risk of this communicable disease, while also developing on options for the longer term.

Government advice – in for a long haul!

This week the federal and NSW governments advised that restrictions on gatherings and movement would likely continue for months, and provided some initial reports that the great response by Australians so far appears to be slowing down spread of the disease. So we are planning to ensure that we can keep 'together in spirit' through the long haul.

Readings and videos for other Holy Week services will be distributed during the week. This includes '**Holy Week at Home**' resources, courtesy of the Archdiocese of Brisbane, to assist you to observe at home.
